

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING

Notice is hereby given that Muscatine Power and Water Company (MPW), with its principal place of business at 3205 Cedar Street, Muscatine, Iowa 52761, proposes to construct a combined heat and power (CHP) generating facility at the existing power generation site located at 1700 Dick Drake Way in Muscatine, Iowa.

CHP facilities have the capability to produce electric power as well as thermal power. The proposed CHP facility would be capable of producing variable output of up to 45 MW of energy in combination with the output of process steam.

The proposed generating facility will interconnect to existing infrastructure, including the 69 kV Muscatine Power and Water owned and controlled electrical substation located in Section 14, Township 76 North, Range 2 West of the 5th Principal Meridian in Muscatine County as well as existing process steam and feedwater lines located on the same property.

Through this project, MPW seeks to maintain system reliability through the development of a thermal generation resource and intends to use the generating facility to reduce emissions from its existing coal-fired generation while maintaining capacity and minimizing the impact to Muscatine Power and Water customers. The proposed generating facility will be owned, operated, and maintained by Muscatine Power and Water and no easements or eminent domain will be sought for the project.
