### **Beware of TSA PreCheck Scams!**

With the holiday season in full swing, many air travelers rely on TSA PreCheck for faster, hassle-free airport screening. But be aware: scammers are targeting travelers by impersonating TSA PreCheck in phishing emails. Here's how the scam works and what to look out for:

You may receive an email that appears to come from TSA PreCheck, prompting you to enroll or renew your membership via an included link. However, this link leads to a fake website that mimics the TSA PreCheck site. Any information entered there — especially financial details — goes straight to the scammers, compromising both your money and personal data.

Additional tips to know:

- · Avoid unexpected links in emails.
- Be wary of urgent payment requests.
- Remember, TSA PreCheck enrollment requires in-person payment, and official emails won't have direct payment links.
