New Arrivals at MPW's Generation Site

We're thrilled to share some exciting news from our generation site — two baby Peregrine falcons, one male and one female, have hatched! These remarkable birds are part of a long-standing conservation effort supported by the Raptor Resource Project and the lowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR).

As part of the program, the chicks were recently banded with state and federal leg bands. This helps researchers track their movements and monitor the health of the species. MPW is one of only 12 registered Peregrine falcon nesting sites in lowa, and even proud to report that 23 chicks have successfully hatched here over the past eleven years.

Special thanks go to Amy (pictured), one of our power plant electricians, who also serves as MPW's liaison with the IDNR. Her dedication helps ensure these birds have a safe and successful start.





Peregrine falcons are known for their incredible speed — reaching up to 260 mph when diving. Once these young falcons are ready, they'll take flight into the lowa skies, continuing the legacy of this once-endangered species.
